What's Happening next?

Parking Enforcement: Starting from 19th February. Park Direct UK will be overseeing parking enforcement. Please contact us and ensure your car registration details are up to date with BHA to avoid any issues. **Any cars parked without a permit will be fined.**

Mind the Markings: You should see more markings and signs on the estate. Please be aware of designated parking spaces marked clearly. If you have a designated space, make sure you park there to avoid any issues.

No Designated Space? If you don't have a designated parking space, please contact Islington Council for a parking permit to park on street nearby. Unauthorised parking has the potential to cause access problems, and we've heard from residents who expressed concerns about unauthorised parking in the estate.
