Overall impression

The building is looking well maintained with the communal cleaning done fortnightly.

Cleaning, gardening and windows in shared areas

Cleaning of shared areas, including the windows is now being done by contractor Dove. We will be consulting you later this year on cleaning of individual flat windows. With the building being on a busy main road, some of these windows are hard to reach.

Main action points:

Loose cables

We noticed some loose cables in the shared area and will get these tied back.

Items stored in the basement

We cannot let you store paint or other flammable items in the basement.

Please clear all unwanted items from the basement by 30 September.

We are now reviewing the arrangement for storing items in the basement and will let you know what we decide.
