Overall impression

Overall, all the blocks are well maintained and the communal area is kept clean and tidy. Windows and flooring all looking okay. No issues found.

Cleaning, gardening and windows in shared areas

Cleaning of shared areas including the windows there is done fortnightly by contractors Dove. Doves also cleans the outside of these windows every other month.

Main action points

We have noticed tenants are still leaving door mats and other items in the communal areas. Anything left in a shared area can turn into a safety hazard in the event of a fire breaking out.

Letters will be going out to all tenants advising that nothing, not even door mats, should be left in shared areas.

We will serve TORT notices on any items we find. The tenants responsible will be billed for the cost to us of removing and disposing of their items.

Just outside the door at 60 Morland Mews you will find a new suggestion box for you to post ideas or suggestions for our services.
