Overall impression

All blocks are clean and tidy. There are no issues with the cleaning in shared areas. The carpet, however, is very worn so will be added to a future programme of upgrades.

Tenants are advised not to leave any items in the communal area including door mats, wheelchairs and mobility walkers/scooters. These are a fire risk or could cause a dangerous obstruction in a fire so should be stored in your flat.

Would all tenants using a wheelchair or mobility scooter please remove them from shared parts of the building.

Overgrown ivy

Colette will discuss cutting back ivy that is blocking the light to one flat.
