Overall impression

Overall, all blocks are clean and tidy. Tenants have been spoken to and written to about not storing any of their items, including door mats, in a communal area. Communal area being cleaned weekly and no issues have been reported.

Main action points

Paving slabs

Slabs outside block 1-6 need to be levelled to remove a trip hazard.

Fire risk action

The storage cupboard needs to be cleared of all items stored in it.

Damaged fencing

Some fencing near the rear of 85 Ronalds Road needs to be mended or replaced.

Other improvements

Small renovations

Items to be considered for the next internal improvements include painting scuffed walls, holders for remote controls, new grouting for external tiling and replacement chair coverings.
